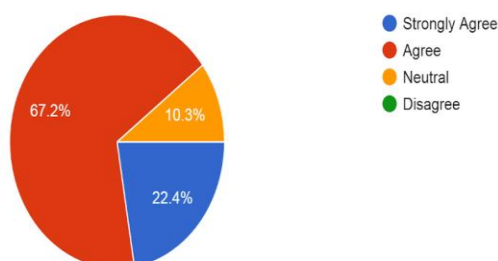
Graphical Interpretation of the Responses

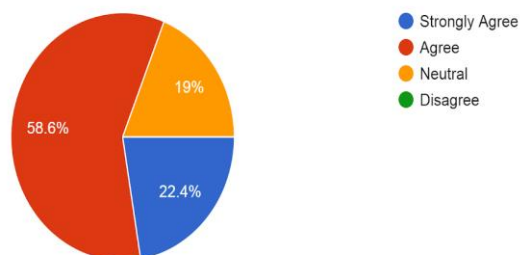

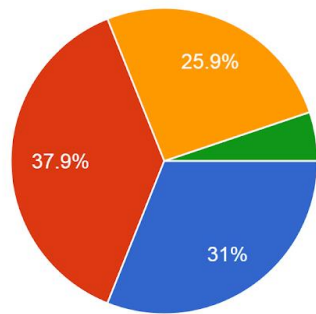


Comprehending the nature of the work

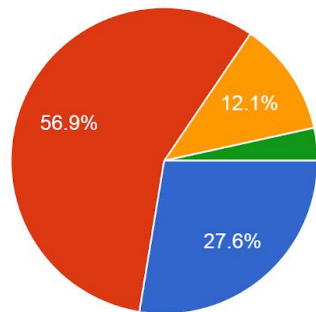
Developing practical solutions to work place problems

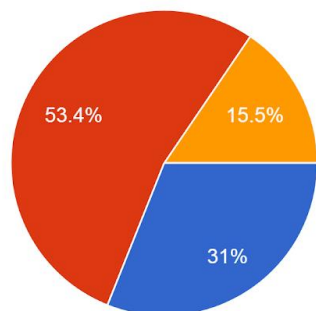
Creative in response to workplace challenges

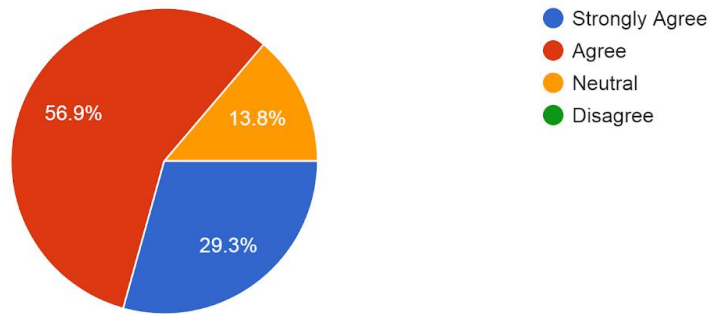
Planning and organization skills

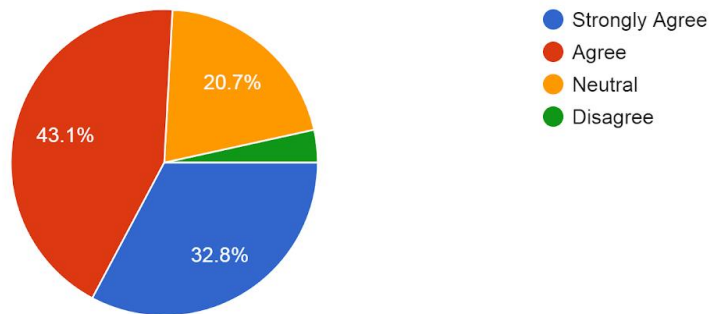

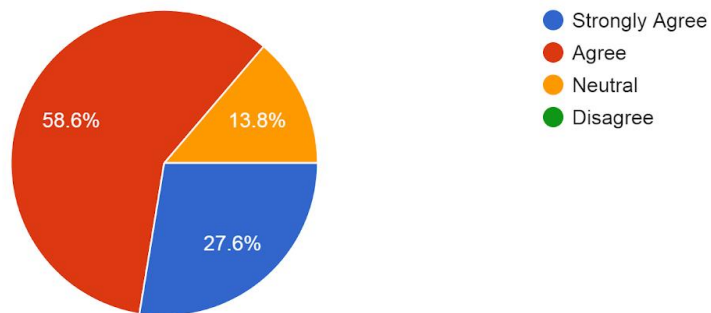

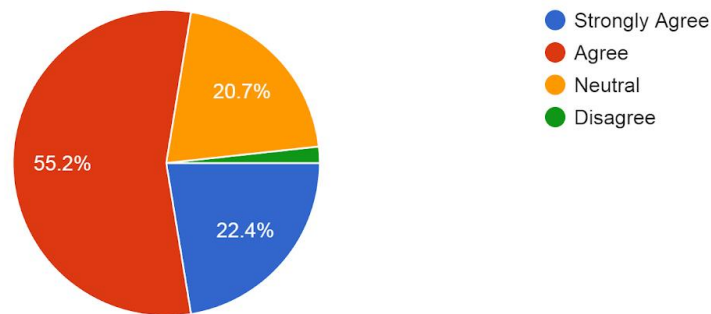


Technical knowledge/skill

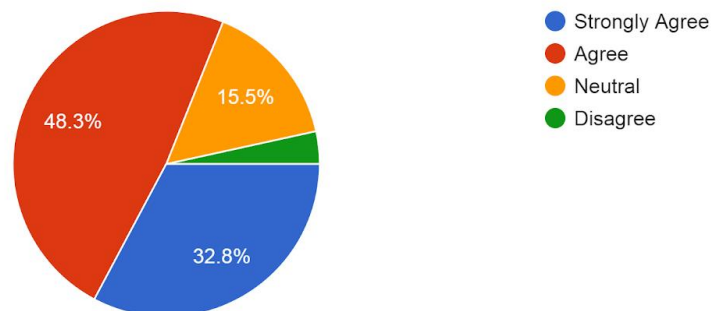

Feedback Analysis & Action Taken / 2020 - 2021

Criterion	Analysis	Action Taken
General communication skills	The employers of the graduates of the institution feel the communication skills needed for the work spot are yet to be improved.	The institution has been offering special courses on 'Business English' and 'Communicative English'. In addition, the affiliating university offers Add-on Courses titled 'Professional

		English Training’.
Comprehending the nature of the work	A few respondents feel that the employees are slow in comprehending and mastering the work, assigned by the employers.	The learners will be given more exposure to practical experiences through Internship Training programmes.
Developing practical solutions to work place problems	A few employers feel the theoretical knowledge of the employees does not help them to solve the practical problems that arise in the work spot.	This opinion of the employers is taken into consideration. More internship and Hands-on-training programmes have been planned to enhance the skill in problem solving.
Creative in response to workplace challenges	The respondents are satisfied with the performance of the employees and their readiness to face the challenges and creativity.	No alternate suggestion is needed.
Planning and organization skills	Some of the employers expect more leadership qualities among their employees.	Workshops have been planned and Lectures on ‘Occupational Skills’ has been given.
Being self-motivated and taking on appropriate level of responsibility	The readiness among the employees to accept any sort of responsibility for the welfare of the organization is acceptable to the employers.	No alternate suggestions needed.
Using technology and workplace equipment	Most of the employers are quite happy about the skill of the employers in handling the tools in technology.	So no alterations are needed.
Technical knowledge/skill	There is a common notion that the employees have to keep developing their occupational skills still more.	The institution plans to conduct workshops and skill set development programmes in future.
